



Grazers G1 Concentrate

Effective against foliar damage from rabbits, pigeons and deer

Contains Calcium and other ingredients:

Calcium Chloride Solution - 6% Calcium Oxide, 4.5% w/w Calcium

Dilution: 4 capfuls (60ml) in 5 litres of water (3 teaspoons per litre).

In areas of high pest numbers it is safe to double the application rate and increase frequency.

Spray interval: 4 weeks or less e.g. in situations where treated grass is mown, plants are watered or periods of prolonged heavy rainfall follows spraying, repeat applications may be needed sooner.

New plants are especially vulnerable to damage. Spray at least twice prior to planting (allow leaf to dry between sprays). Spray again once planted. Avoid spraying in bright sunlight.

Shake vigorously before use. Spray foliage (using a fine spray) on any plants while dry, where damage has occurred or is at risk. Spray foliage until just wet.

Note: It is advisable to add a small amount of washing up liquid (eg. 1 drop per litre).

Harvest interval: For edible crops we recommend one weeks interval between final treatment & harvest. Storage: Will keep for 2 years when stored in cool, dark conditions.

Grazers is very safe to use and benefits the plant.

Allow leaf to dry before applying other products.
